### Information about the personal data processing pursuant to the articles 13 and 14 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679

#### a) Identity and contact details of the data Controller

#### c) Purposes of the data processing and legal basis

The **University of Torino** is a public institution of high culture which carries out, pursuant to the art. 6, paragraph 1, let. e) of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679, data processing for **institutional purposes of higher education and research** (art. 1 of the University of Torino Statute), in implementation of the art. 33 of the Constitution. The legal basis, pursuant to the art. 6, paragraph 3 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679, is the law n° 168/1989.

Furthermore, the **University of Torino**, in the context of **First Life** and related research projects, will process your personal data for the following purposes under the following legal bases:

#### d) The First Life research project

**First Life** is a civic social network developed for the creation, sharing and the exchange of information among private and public subject involved in social, commercial and recreational initiatives and in the management of social services, at different scale from the square to the city and beyond. **First Life** is a crowdsourcing platform based on an interactive map where the content concerns the activities and the projects associate to the place and where is possible to interact with other users taking part to discussion, thematic groups and events.



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**First Life** allows to create newsfeed on the places on the map, rather than on own personal page. Citizens, associations, institutions can post on the map places, events, news, stories and create groups. They will appear on the newsfeed of the area that you are viewing and can be filtered through a time window. The users can register themselves on the entities and reach news on them and became members of groups, in order to coordinate with each other in a bottom up manner.

### e) Personal data categories

The personal data that you provide us are needed to allow the research activities and the consequent legal fulfillments. The data will be processed in respect to the deontological rules – “*Regole deontologiche per trattamenti a fini statistici o di ricerca scientifica*” (G.U. January 14, 2019 n° 11).

The **University of Torino** as **data Controller**, in the context of the activities related to **First Life** and other related research projects (of which you will receive specific information and with respect to which will always be obtained your consent) will process the following categories of personal data:

- Data necessary to univocally identify a user account, such as your username or the numeric ID that we will assign to your account;
- Identification data necessary to associate a user account with an accredited person, such as your name and surname, your date of birth (in order to verify your majority) and the e-mail address indicated by you;
- Profile data spontaneously provided by you, such as your profile image;
- Content and usage data, that is the data created during the use of **First Life**, also as a result of interaction with other users of **First Life**, and all the data created by interaction with the **First Life** components. For instance, will be processed the data related to the entity created by you or with which you have interacted, or will be processed the data related to the post created by you or to the initiatives created by you or with which you have interacted;
- Login and settings data;
- Web server log data, that is the data which are generated whenever the logger is used, either to store or to retrieve events, such as your IP address or the URL requested.
- Data collected if the data subject use the Facebook or Google platforms for the registration to **First Life**. For instance, will be collected, in these cases, the Facebook or Google ID, name and surname and the e-mail address.

### f) Collection of personal data

The data are provided by the data subject during the registration process, moreover the data are collected following the use of **First Life** by the data subject. Finally, the data could be provided from third parties, if the data subjects use the Facebook or Google platforms for the registration in **First Life**.

### g) Personal data recipients and eventual categories of personal data recipients

The personal data are processed within the institution by authorized subject under the responsibility of the **data Controller** for the aforementioned purposes in compliance with the deontological rule and the ethical code.

Moreover, we inform you that the data collected will be used in an anonymous form for scientific research analysis in the context of research projects related to **First Life** and they could be transmitted to research



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partner or regulatory authorities. The purpose of the verification activities is to control the fair execution of the research activity in compliance with the current provisions.

The special categories of personal data will be processed in compliance with the D.Lgs 101/2018 and in compliance with the general measures of the Italian supervisory Authority.

The personal data could be transmitted to cloud service providers. About that it has been identified as **data Processor: Digital Ocean LLC, 101 Avenue of the Americas, 10th Floor, New York, NY 10013.**

Moreover, we inform you that the relationship between **University of Torino** and **Digital Ocean LLC**, as regard data processing, is regulated through an agreement pursuant to article 28 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679.

### **h) Transfers of personal data to third countries or international organisations**

The data processing carried out by the **University of Torino** in the context of the **First Life** project and in the context of the research activities related to **First Life** doesn't foresee data transfer outside the EEA (European Economic Area).

### **i) Personal data storage period**

**First Life** personal data and personal data of the **First Life** related projects will be stored for the necessary time to guarantee the correct functioning of **First Life**, or until you, as **First Life** user, keep active your **First Life** account. Furthermore, the personal data, once anonymized, could be reused for other scientific purposes.

### **j) Rights of the data subjects**

In relation to your personal data, you can exercise free of charge the rights provided by the articles from 15 to 22 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 where applicable, sending a specific instance with the object: "*Privacy Rights*" to the address [privacy@firstlife.org](mailto:privacy@firstlife.org).

In order to exercise your rights your instance must accompanied with a valid copy of an ID document.

The **University of Torino** will provide you information about the action taken pursuant to the articles from 15 to 22 of the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 within one month from the receiving of the instance, with the chance to extend up to two months, taking account of the number and the complexity of the instances presented.

### **k) Lodge a complaint**

You, as data subject, have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory Authority, contacting "*Autorità Garante per la protezione dei dati personali*": <https://www.garanteprivacy.it/>, or contacting the supervisory Authority in the Member State of your habitual residence, place of work or the supervisory Authority of the place of the alleged infringement.

### **l) Withdrawal of the consent**

Where the data processing is based on the consent that you freely given, you have the right to withdraw the consent at any time (the withdrawal of the consent doesn't affect the lawfulness of the data processing carried out before the withdrawal of the consent).

### **m) Provision of data**

The data subject is obliged to provide the data. Failure to provide data does not allow you to take part in the project.



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Taking part of the project is free and voluntary, the non-participation doesn't bring any consequence for the data subject.

### **n) Profiling**

The **data Controller** doesn't use automated processes aimed at profiling.
